This worldwide procedure is performed for health, religious, or cultural reasons shortly after birth, around puberty, or during young adulthood. The World Health Organization (WHO), the Joint United Nations Program on HIV and AIDS (UNAIDS), and the Center for Disease Control (CDC) state evidence that indicates male circumcision significantly reduces the risk of female-to-male HIV transmission by over 50%. The Circumcision Trainers have been developed with the assistance from one of the top medical schools in Wisconsin, USA, as well as medical professionals in South Africa and Indonesia. The trainers include the foreskin, glans penis, frenulum, meatus, and coronal groove. These trainers are made with soft, lifelike material, which is pliable, delicate, and realistic to the touch. Medical students, physicians, and other practitioners can learn, practice, and

improve realistic, hands-on skills for this delicate procedure without the worry of learning on a live patient. Practice simulating dorsal block injection, separating the inner lining of the foreskin (preputial epithelium) from its attachment to the glans, surgical removal of the foreskin, and suturing techniques. These trainers may also be used to demonstrate the procedure and practice aftercare skills to family members. Since there are different methods of circumcision, the Circumcision Trainers have been designed for Mogen clamp method, Guillotine clamp method, Gomco clamp method, Plastibell method, dorsal slit method, forceps guided method, and sleeve circumcision. Includes one base, six glans penis cores, six foreskins, instruments (scalpel, 4-1/2" micro-forceps, 6" precision probe, Iris research scissors, 5" straight Halstead mosquito forceps, 5" curved Halstead mosquito forceps, Ethicon suture thread with needle), instrument case, instructions, and soft nylon carrying case.

Q: What is the difference between the Teen and Infant Circumcision Training Kits? A: The Teen kit (W44064TN / LF00921U) is sized and anatomically scaled for adolescent and young adult patients — the age group in whom circumcision is performed for clinical reasons (phimosis, balanitis), religious reasons, or HIV-prevention programme contexts. The Infant kit (W44064IN / LF00920U) is sized for neonatal circumcision. Both are available from SEM Trainers.

Q: How many practice exercises can be performed per kit? A: The kit includes 6 glans penis cores and 6 foreskins — each providing a full circumcision training exercise. After completion, the used foreskin is removed and replaced with a fresh one for the next trainee. Six full procedure exercises are available per kit at the outset; replacement foreskins can be enquired about through SEM Trainers.

Q: Which circumcision methods can be trained with this kit? A: Seven — Mogen clamp, Guillotine clamp, Gomco clamp, Plastibell, dorsal slit, forceps-guided, and sleeve circumcision. The trainer is designed to accommodate all seven methods currently in clinical use.

Q: Are all instruments included? A: Yes. The kit includes a scalpel, 4½" micro-forceps, 6" precision probe, Iris research scissors, 5" straight and curved Halstead mosquito forceps, and Ethicon suture thread with needle — a complete instrument set for all seven methods. Clamps (Mogen, Gomco, Plastibell) are not included as they are typically available in the institution's surgical instrument inventory.

Q: Is this kit relevant for HIV-prevention training programmes in India? A: Yes. WHO, UNAIDS, and CDC evidence confirms that male circumcision reduces female-to-male HIV transmission risk by over 50%. For NACO-aligned HIV-prevention programme providers building circumcision service delivery capacity in India, the Teen kit trains the appropriate technique for the post-pubertal patient age group most commonly targeted by voluntary medical male circumcision (VMMC) programmes.
