Product Description

This injection arm simulates those of a one year old. Features: • Medial venous structure • Two veins in dorsum of hand • Radial and brachial arteries • Squeeze bulb simulating either collapsed or normal veins • Easily replaceable skin and veins that withstand multiple needle sticks • Mounted on smoked Lucite® base and supplied with blood bag and stand, synthetic blood concentrate, squeeze bulb, and spare arm skin • Soft carrying bag • Instruction manual

Another one with missing fields — worth flagging together since it's a cluster of gaps, not just one:

1. **No "Make:" / brand field** — same gap as the Nursing Baby page. MPN format "S406.M" doesn't match the Nasco patterns we've seen so far (LF-prefixed or plain SS-10/ST2M-10 style), so I'm not going to guess. Given "Life/form® Single Intraosseous Infusion Leg" and "Skin and Veins"

show up as related products, there's a reasonable chance this is part of the same injection-arm family as other Nasco/Life-form products — but "reasonable chance" isn't good enough to print as fact.

2. **No weight listed** — unlike most other pages in this batch, there's no weight field at all here, not even a suspect 0.001 kg placeholder.
3. **Placeholder product image** — the live page is using the generic WooCommerce placeholder graphic, not an actual photo of the arm.

None of these block writing the copy, but all three are worth fixing on the live listing — a buyer can't tell what they're ordering from a placeholder image with an unnamed manufacturer.

The One Year Injection Training Arm (Item No. 1018861 [W45165], MPN: S406.M) by **[CONFIRM MANUFACTURER]** simulates the venous and arterial anatomy of a one-year-old infant, giving students a dedicated pediatric practice surface separate from adult injection arms.

Anatomical features: medial venous structure, two veins in the dorsum of the hand, and radial and brachial arteries, replicating the key venipuncture landmarks nursing and medical students need to locate on a real infant patient. A squeeze bulb lets instructors simulate either collapsed or normal veins, adding a diagnostic/technique-adjustment element beyond simple needle-stick practice.

Built for repeated classroom use. The skin and veins are easily replaceable and designed to withstand multiple needle sticks, so the arm can support a full term's worth of student practice rather than needing frequent replacement. It's mounted on a smoked Lucite® base for stable desktop use during skills sessions.

Supplied with: Blood bag and stand, synthetic blood concentrate, squeeze bulb, spare arm skin, soft carrying bag, instruction manual.
