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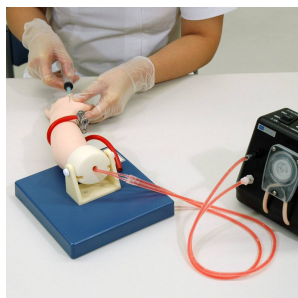

Simulator Pediatric IV Hand — Dorsal Vein Injection & Blood Collection Trainer for Infants and Toddlers

The Simulator Pediatric IV Hand (Item No. M95) by Kyoto Kagaku, Japan is a set of pediatric injection hands built for practicing dorsal vein IV access, blood collection, and intravenous infusion on two distinct pediatric age groups in a single kit — one-year-old and three-year-old anatomy.

Realistic hand mechanics for pediatric technique. The fingers and dorsum of each hand are flexible, grippable, and repositionable, closely mirroring how a real pediatric patient's hand behaves during an IV procedure. Each hand has two puncture sites on the back of the hand, and students can practice the full workflow through to dressing and securing the cannula — not just the needle insertion itself.

Why two age groups matter: pediatric vein access technique differs meaningfully between a one-year-old and a three-year-old due to vein size, hand proportions, and cooperation level. Training on both age groups in the same kit gives students broader pattern recognition before they encounter the full range of pediatric patients in clinical postings.

What's included: 2 injection arm-hands (one-year-old), 2 injection arm-hands (three-year-old), 2 stands, 1 circulation pump, 10 red cotton swabs, 1 spoon, 1 plastic jar, 1 plastic beaker, 1 storage case, and an instruction manual. The circulation pump runs on AC100V–240V, 50/60Hz (approx. 5W).

Recommended needles: 23G indwelling needle or 23G butterfly needle (needles not included).

Replacement parts available: 11350-010 (three-year-old hand), 11350-020 (one-year-old hand), 11388-400 (10 red cotton swabs) — useful for institutions planning ahead for consumable replacement in high-throughput training programmes.

Q: Are needles included? A: No — needles are not included. Recommended sizes are 23G indwelling or 23G butterfly needles.

Q: What age groups does this cover? A: Both a one-year-old and a three-year-old pediatric hand are included in the same kit, letting students practice across two distinct pediatric anatomies.

Q: Can individual hands be replaced separately? A: Yes — replacement hands are available for both the one-year-old (11350-020) and three-year-old (11350-010) versions, along with replacement cotton swabs (11388-400).
